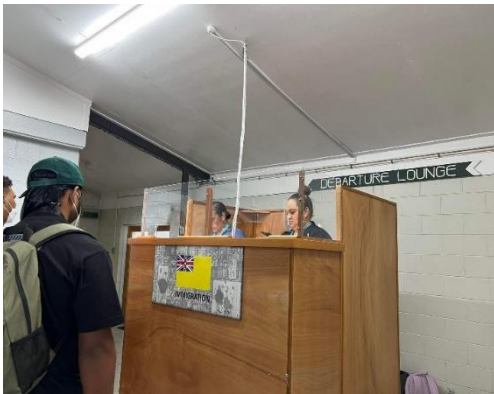

Niue Immigration Launch **ASYPX**

On Friday 13th January 2023, the Niue Immigration Department launched its new automated software “ASYPX” for passenger processing at its HANAN international airport.

ASYPX is developed by the United Nations Conference of Trade and Development (UNCTAD) with funding support under the PACER Plus project. Niue is the second country in the Pacific to implement this project. On behalf of the Niue Government and Department of Immigration, we extend our sincere gratitude to New Zealand Government (NZ AID) and the Australian Government (AUSAID) for the opportunity to automate our Immigration business processes.

Processing 143 departing passengers including New Zealand deputy High Commissioner, Nigel Ewels, and on arrival 111 passengers including the New Zealand High Commissioner to Niue H.E. Helen Tunnah and Niue Minister of Finance Hon. Crossley Tatui. The immigration officers appreciated the ease of processing passengers in the system. Onsite support was provided by the UNCTAD expert Patricia Havan and the Niue Project Manager.

The live implementation of ASYPX is a great achievement while the best is yet to come; so, watch this space!

Immigration training and testing of **ASYPX**

The Immigration officers' training was conducted by the UNCTAD expert at the Government building conference room, assisted by the National Project manager. The officers were trained to capture passengers' details by manual data entry as well as utilization of passport readers.

The training second session was held at the Hanan international airport to ensure readiness of the officers for the flight on Friday, 13th January 2023.

The comptroller of Customs, Ms. Doreen SIATAGA expressed her support by visiting immigration officers during their training.

The immigration officers were satisfied with the outcome of the new system, achieving higher standard, and saving processing time in contrast with their manual procedure.
